

OUR PASTOR IS BEING MOVED TO ANOTHER CHURCH— HOW IS THIS DECISION MADE?

In The United Methodist Church clergy appointments are made annually by the Bishop and District Superintendents, who have the responsibility for setting all the pastoral appointments in the conference. This system of assigning clergy dates back to John Wesley.

United Methodist elders vow at their ordination to participate in the itineracy – to move from place to place as appointed by the bishop of the Annual Conference of which they are members. They agree to serve where sent and to accept and abide by the appointment.

While bishops and their cabinet make appointments, there is an ongoing conversation between the Bishop, their DS, the pastor and the churches SPRC committee. A profile is developed which advises the bishop on the local church's mission and ministry needs - to be used in appointment making. They look at what clergy are available, considering their gifts and talents, as well as their compensation schedule, which is based on years of service, and the local church budget and so much more. Everything is taken into consideration. but the mission of the church comes first. Each move is the culmination" of the prayer, deliberation and discernment that happened as the decision was made. Regardless of what sparks a change of pastors in a local church, seldom is only one congregation affected. Chains of appointment changes often start when someone retires, creating a domino effect with subsequent vacancies to fill.

While changes in appointments for pastors and for local churches "don't always come when and where we prefer, pastors and congregations alike will report that they have had some good appointments, some not-so-good appointments and, overall, most seem to work out quite well."
